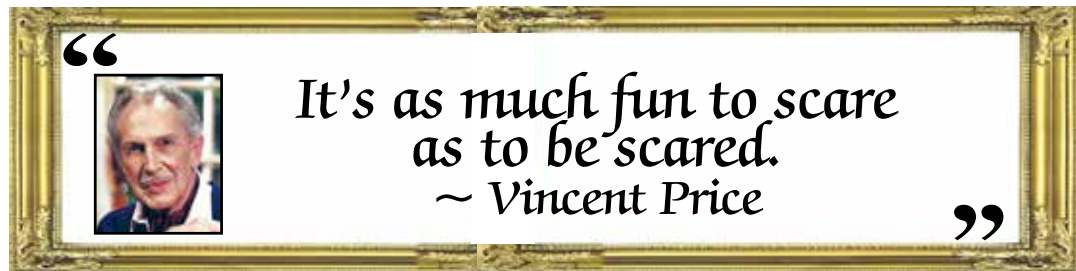

SPOOKY SEASON SNACKS POP UP SCARY SWEET HALLOWEEN TREATS

Scaring up a good time this Halloween starts with spooky costumes, ghoulish decor and treats you can share with your favorite ghosts and goblins. For an extra haunting twist, skip the store-bought candies and break out your cauldron for tempting homemade sweets.

You can celebrate the seed-to-snack simplicity of one of fall's favorite snacks – popcorn – with crunchy desserts that pair perfectly with your favorite spooky traditions. Popcorn's smell, taste and versatility help it enhance Halloween as a budget-friendly solution for ghostly gatherings.

Embrace the taste of autumn – pumpkin spice – with a snack that allows you to indulge throughout the season. These White Chocolate and Pumpkin Pie Spice Popcorn Bites offer warm flavor without the scare. Simply pour melted pumpkin pie spice-seasoned chocolate over popped popcorn, toss with toffee bits and sea salt then break into bite-sized chunks for a seasonal sweet that's perfect for celebrating National Popcorn Poppin' Month.

Go for a Ghoulish Snack Bar
 Encourage a little devious creativity this Halloween with a popcorn bar (char-boo-terie board) that features everyone's favorites. Start with enough freshly popped popcorn to feed all your little zombies and vampires then add

seasonal favorites like candy corn, chocolate candies, individually wrapped treats, dried fruit, nuts and beyond.

To pop popcorn on a stovetop, cover the bottom of a 3- to 4-quart pan with a thin layer of vegetable oil (don't use butter, it will burn). Place 3 kernels of popcorn in the pan, cover with a loose lid that allows steam to escape and heat. When the kernels pop, pour in enough popcorn to cover the bottom of the pan, one kernel deep, then cover the pan and shake to evenly spread the oil. When the popping begins to slow to a few seconds apart, remove the pan from the stovetop. The heated oil will still pop the remaining kernels.

White Chocolate and Pumpkin Pie Spice Popcorn Bites

- Servings: 12
- 12 cups unsalted, unbuttered popped popcorn
 - 3 cups chopped white chocolate or white chocolate chips
 - 1 tablespoon light olive oil
 - 2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
 - 1/2 cup toffee bits
 - 1 teaspoon flaked sea salt, crushed

Line large, rimmed baking sheet with parchment paper or wax paper. Place popcorn in large mixing bowl.

In microwave-safe bowl, combine white chocolate, olive oil and pumpkin pie spice; microwave on medium 2-3 minutes, or until melted and smooth,



stirring after each minute.
 Pour melted white chocolate mixture over popcorn; add toffee bits and toss to combine. Transfer to prepared baking sheet, spreading to edges of pan; sprinkle sea salt over top.

Let cool; refrigerate 1-2 hours, or until set. Break into chunks for serving.
 Tip: Homemade pumpkin pie spice can be made by combining 3 parts ground cinnamon with 1 part ground nutmeg, 1 part allspice and 1 part ginger.

DEL MAR'S URBANA MEXICAN GASTRONOMY DISHES UP AUTHENTIC MEXICAN CUISINE

Restaurateur Javier Cuadra, born in Michoacán, Mexico, drew inspiration from his homeland's rich culture and street food to open his own restaurant. While studying international business, Javier worked in the restaurant industry, which fueled his dream of showcasing Mexico's unique cuisine in Orange County, where he noticed a lack of authentic Mexican street food. This passion led to the creation of URBANA Mexican Gastronomy & Mixology, a vibrant eatery known for its natural, fresh ingredients, handmade tortillas, gourmet tacos, and snapper ceviche, crafted by Executive Chef Ernie Alvarado. Javier's favorite dish, mole enchiladas, is made with house-made mole sauce that reminds him of home.

Their success has led to a second URBANA location at Del Mar's Sky Deck, where Frank and I were able to enjoy an exceptional culinary experience. From the moment we arrived, we were welcomed warmly by the hostess, Marty, and seated in the capable hands of Tito Nava, our server for the evening. The personal touch of Floor Manager Eric Hitchcock, who made sure every detail was on point, elevated the entire dining experience. Ernie's background is as fascinating as his dedication—he served in the Navy and later earned a degree in political science and international relations from USD before joining the food and beverage industry. He

has been with URBANA since 2021, bringing his passion for hospitality to life every day.

Tito and Eric encouraged us to begin with signature drinks. I opted for the Paloma, a refreshing blend of tequila blanco, agave, lime, grapefruit soda, chamoy, and chile con limón. Its tartness and spice made it an ideal complement to our appetizers. Frank enjoyed the Urbana Margarita, a fresh and vibrant take on a classic, with tequila blanco, agave, and citrus, finished with a salt rim. The drinks paired beautifully with our two starters—the Gringa Pork Quesadilla and the Red Snapper Ceviche.

The Gringa Pork Quesadilla featured flavorful al pastor-style pork with melted cheese. It was a hearty and savory appetizer, rich in bold Mexican flavors. The Red Snapper Ceviche, was a bright and fresh contrast. The lime-cured snapper, stacked in Pico de Gallo and topped with house-made guac, was served with crispy tostaditas.

Next came an impressive array of tacos, which highlighted the range of flavors URBANA offers. First up were the Baja Fish Tacos, made with that day's catch, Mahi Mahi, battered and fried to golden perfection, topped with spicy aioli and crunchy cabbage. The balance between the fish's delicate flavor and the crisp exterior was remarkable. Next, we had Carnitas Pork Tacos, which featured juicy pork, habanero salsa, and pickled onions, with a touch of queso fresco. The Lobster Taco, a specialty taco, stood out for its luxurious combination of ingredients. The tender lobster, paired with corn esquite, queso fresco, avocado, and chipotle, all inside a soft blue corn tortilla, was divine. To top it off, the Quesa-Birria Plate arrived, featuring three beef tacos filled with queso Oaxaca, topped with pickled red onion and cilantro. Served with a rich consommé for dipping, these tacos were a mouthwatering fusion of flavors and textures.

We met Chef Ernie when he presented the Mole Enchiladas and Ribeye Torta from the Chef's Offering section. Growing up near Guadalajara, like Javier, the two quickly bonded over their shared heritage of food. Ernie shared, "Our goal is true flavors, not flooded with rice, beans, and cheese."

A self-taught chef, Ernie started as a busboy and worked his way up to prep chef and sous chef, spending 10 years in Costa Mesa before joining URBANA as Executive Chef. "I am an artist in the kitchen, food is my tapestry," he remarked. Chef Ernie takes pride in creating à la carte dishes with diverse flavors and believes that "less is more" to let the true flavors shine.

The Mole Enchiladas, filled with Jidori chicken and melted queso Oaxaca was smothered in a luscious house-made mole sauce. The mole, rich but not overpowering, perfectly balanced the smoky and sweet flavors that define this classic Mexican dish.

The food was so impressive that I couldn't resist returning the following week with my wife. On this visit, I tried the Al Pastor Nachos, a dish piled high with layers of goodness. The golden nachos were topped with al pastor pork, melted queso Oaxaca, crema,

guacamole, Pico de Gallo, pickled Fresno chilies, and chipotle salsa. Perfect for sharing, this dish was an indulgent treat that could easily serve four people. A steak version is also available.

URBANA's food is truly a culinary masterpiece, and it's delivered in a full-service, casual, and energetic environment. The pricing is fair for the high-quality dishes, making it a go-to spot for a memorable dining experience. Whether you're visiting for lunch, dinner, or their generous happy hour (Monday-Friday from 3:00-6:00 PM and all weekend long from 2:00-4:00PM), URBANA offers something special for everyone. MONTANA ISLAND SALE – LAKE MONSTER LURKS NEARBY LISTED FOR \$72 MILLION



Although Montana has one of the smallest populations of America’s 50 states - about one-eighth the size of New York City - the state has become a hot spot for celebrities. While Beverly Hills and New York are always the favorite towns for celebrities to live most of the year, many are buying second homes in Big Sky country. Propelled by Covid, a quest for a simpler life, and a break from the Hollywood craziness, more and more celebrities including Justin Timberlake and Jessica Biel, Tom Brady, and Bill Gates own homes in Montana. And Ben Affleck where he and Jennifer Lopez reignited their love life in 2021 at Ben’s seven-bedroom home in the super-upscale Yellowstone Club community.

For celebrities or anyone who aspires to a place in Montana, one of the most interesting offerings is the newly listed Cromwell Island in the center of Flathead Lake. Even larger than Lake Tahoe, Flathead Lake is the largest natural freshwater lake west of the Mississippi. Cromwell is sited in the center of the lake with approximately 2,900 feet of

shoreline and was purchased by antique collector and explorer Robert M. Lee in the late 1980s. He and his wife built the exterior shell of a 45,000-square-foot home and a guest house which they completed. Lee died in 2016 before the interior of the main house was completed. Though only the exterior of the home is complete, it gives the buyer free rein to design the interior layout exactly the way they want it, while living comfortably in the completed guest house. Views from the island are striking with the snowcapped Mission Mountains in the distance and the varying shades of blue in the water as the sun moves east to west.

Legend has it that much like Loch Ness, Flathead Lake has its own water monster, Flessie, decked out in deer antlers. The legend began hundreds of years ago with the Kootenai Indian Tribe and then much later in 1889 when steamboat Captain James C. Kerr and his 100 passengers saw a “whale-like” object on the lake that dove after being shot at by one of the passengers. As



the legend grew, locals began calling the creature “Flessie.” Since then, there are one or two sightings most every year, peaking in 2013 when there were 13 “Flessie” sightings. The perfect perch to view the lake with binoculars is from this \$72 million home on the island.

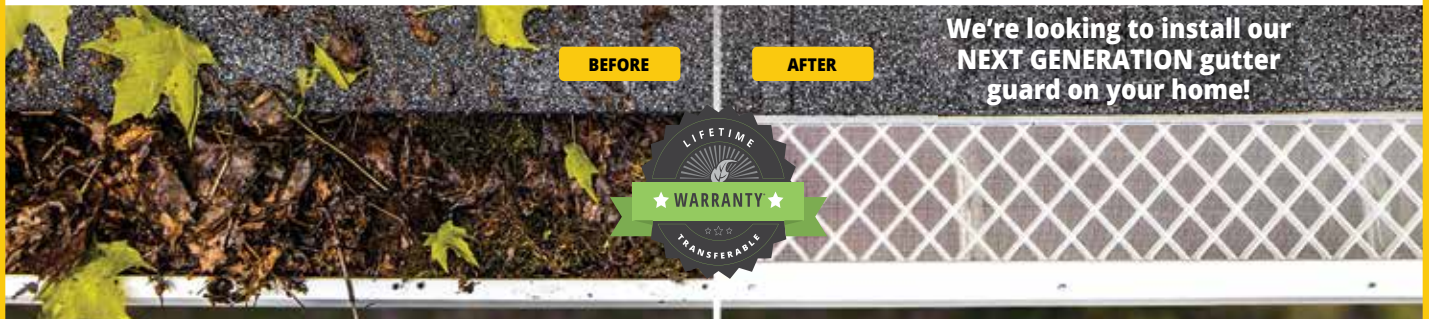
