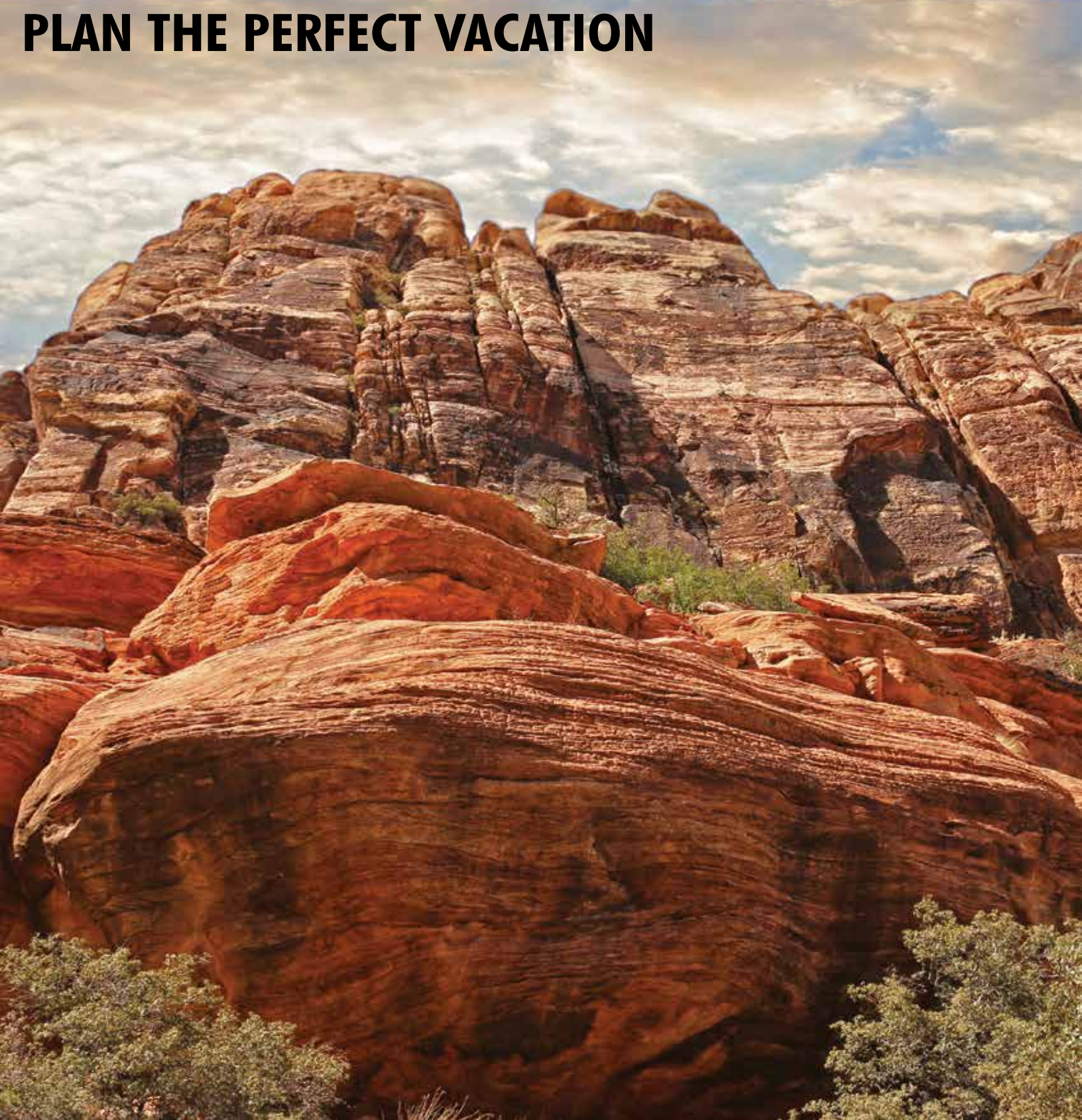

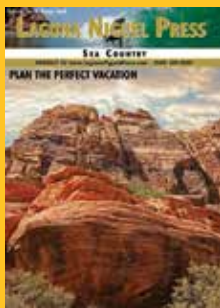

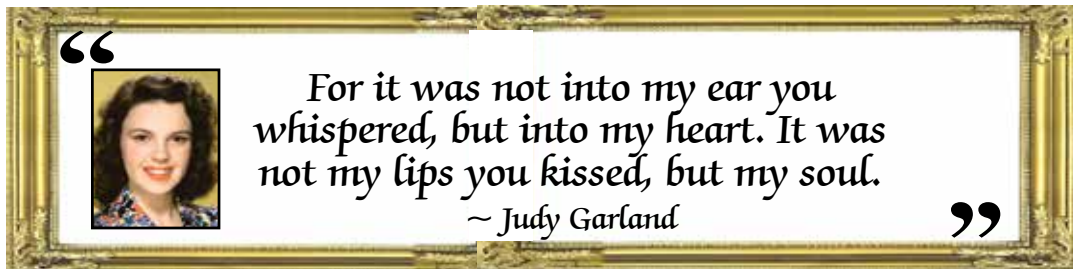

DYNAMIC CHARM: EXPLORE THE 7 UNIQUE NEIGHBORHOODS OF COSTA MESA

Planning a trip to Southern California? You could visit well-known cities like Los Angeles and San Diego ... or stay in a city where you'll have many cultural excursions at your fingertips.

Costa Mesa, located in the heart of Orange County, is a cultural epicenter that locals from surrounding cities flock to for unforgettable events, arts experiences, a diverse shopping scene and culinary creativity. 1. Mesa Verde

Stretch your creativity and unwind at Inspired Art Wine, an art studio, wine bar and gallery where you can take an art class, no experience needed. All classes include a curated wine tasting with delicious food pairings.

2. South Coast Metro

The South Coast Metro area is home to South Coast Plaza, the largest shopping center on the West Coast, attracting over 20 million visitors every year from all over the world. At South Coast Plaza, you'll find top designers - like Christian Dior, Balenciaga, Gucci and Prada - plus boutiques and popups.

When you need a break from shopping, stop by Collage Culinary Experience, a global dining collective with the best international and local

cuisine. There's also no shortage of cultural events at South Coast Plaza. The shopping destination goes all-out with holiday decorations, and not just for mainstream celebrations. Costa Mesa is home to thriving Asian American communities and hosts cultural events for Lunar New Year.

3. SoBeCa District

The SoBeCa (South Bristol Entertainment and Cultural Arts) District has expanded over the years but remains an epicenter for creative makers and small businesses. In this neighborhood, you'll find The LAB Anti-Mall and its offshoot, The CAMP, which provide a truly one-of-a-kind shopping experience.

The LAB (Little American Business) combines diverse cultures with its eclectic array of boutique shops, eateries, art shows, poetry readings and musical performances. Across the street, The CAMP eco-friendly shopping center features health-conscious fitness, creative retailers and mindful culinary options.

4. Theater and Arts District

Costa Mesa is known as the "City of the Arts®," and its heartbeat is located in the Theater and Art District. Whether you want to tour a museum, enjoy a theatrical performance or visit the Costa Mesa Art Walk, you'll be spoiled for choice!

Take a trip down the Avenue of the Arts, and you'll find the Arts Campus where Segerstrom Center for the Arts is located. The center hosts traveling Broadway shows, major ballet companies, international dance troupes and celebrated artists. It's also home to the Pacific Symphony, the Philharmonic Society of Orange County, the Pacific Chorale and the Pacific Symphony, all of which perform at the Renee and Henry Segerstrom Concert Hall. Plus Argyros Plaza hosts free outdoor events throughout the year.

For those who like to mosey through museums, check out the Orange County Museum of Art (OCMA), which recently celebrated its one-year anniversary and houses 4,500 pieces of modern art and



rotating exhibitions. Admission to the museum is free.

5. Central

If you're lucky enough to visit Costa Mesa during the summer, head to the Central neighborhood and enjoy the OC Fair, which delights visitors with a wide array of events, concerts, carnival rides and super-eclectic fair food. If you miss the fair, don't worry. The OC Fair and Events Center has more than 150 events year-round.

Afterward, head next door to Costa Mesa Skate Park, where skaters of all ages and abilities can shred some pipes.

At night, make your way to Triangle Square, which features delicious restaurants and casual entertainment. Enjoy a flamenco dance performance and a three-course meal at Sevilla!

6. Westside

The Westside is the city's industrial center. Its warehouses and garages that once housed boat builders and other industrial businesses have since been transformed into exceptional restaurants, art studios and small businesses.

For example, 2145 Eats was once a vacant gas station but now functions as a restaurant and bar, serving seasonal pizzas, salads, small plates and rotating beer and wine. 2145 Eats' pizza has

been voted Best Pizza in OC, owing to Chef Eduardo Salcedo's innovative Japanese-style dough.

Don't forget to check out what's playing at The Wayfarer's stage, one of Costa Mesa's best live music venues.

7. Eastside

Instagram influencers can capture stunning new content on the Eastside, one of the hippest neighborhoods in Costa Mesa.

Stop by The Crack Shack (run by Richard Blais, winner of "Top Chef: All-Stars") and enjoy fried chicken with a gourmet twist. For specialty craft cocktails and creative pub fare, sit down at The Wild Goose Tavern, which offers rabbit andouille and wild boar burgers and sausages.

Interested in wine tasting? Visit Hi-Time Wine Cellars, a family-owned local wine bar and high-end liquor and beer fridge with one of the largest underground wine cellars in the U.S. After you've tasted their wares, buy a bottle to take home and commemorate your trip.

Taste of Wine & Food

FAMILY WINEMAKERS OF CALIFORNIA ANNUAL TASTING SHOWCASE AT DEL MAR FAIRGROUNDS

Family Winemakers of California, described as an "organization that reflects the small producer's point of view," has been the voice for small, family wineries for 30 years, offering opportunities to engage with winemakers and reps. The Annual Tasting Showcase at Del Mar Fairgrounds serves as a platform for both industry professionals and consumers to discover these wineries.

A good example of meeting with representatives is when Frank and I met Windrun Winery's husband and wife owner team, Adam and Cameron Arealos. The Arealos's purchased the nine-year-old Santa Rita Hills winery in 2019. Adam is the winemaker and is assisted by renowned winemaker Ken Brown. Every limited-production bottling represents hand chosen grapes from select vineyards of Santa Barbara County, most notably the Sta. Rita Hills AVA. Adam and Cameron shared their line up with us that consisted of a 2021 Sta. Rita Hills Chardonnay that was crisp with 50% stainless steel and 50% new French oak fermentation. They were also pouring their 2020 Sta. Rita Hills Grenache (100%), 2019 and 2020 Sta. Rita Hills Pinot Noirs, 2019 Thompson Syrah sourced from Alisos, and their

2020 Sta. Hills Rose. These were great valued wines that are worth trying.

We started the show visiting the Cass Winery booth. Co-owner Ted Plemons was pouring a full line up of wines that exceeded the generous listing advertised. Cass Winery is known for their Rhone style and Bordeaux wines made from estate fruit under the leadership of winemaker Sterling Kragten. They pattern themselves as a French style estate - I love their tagline, "French DNA + Paso Personality." The full Cass line up included: 2023 Viognier, 2023 Marsanne, 2023 Oasis Rose, 2022 Grenache, 2021 Rockin' One Red, 2020 Damas Noir, 2021 Mourvedre, 2020 Backbone Syrah, Vintage Ted, and Ted spoiled a few guests with a bottle of 2019 Reserve Bordeaux. Each year the Reserve Bordeaux is a collection of the best fruit grown on the ranch. The 2019 was beyond delicious with a full-bodied palate, good acidity, and smooth, well integrated tannins. The blend was Cab Sauv (83%) dominate with 8% Petit Verdot, 6% Syrah, and 3% Malbec components and aged for 22 months in new French oak.

Oceanside's Coomber Craft Wines well represented San Diego's North County. We met with owners Maureen and Skip Coomber, also the winemaker, while enjoying two terrific wines. The first was their 2021 Private Reserve Chardonnay sourced from Sta. Rita Hills. The second was 2013 Private Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from Napa Valley, specifically Rutherford. I was glad to hear that their Oceanside location is pumping out music 7 days a week. For music fans, check out their calendar and stop by for great music, delicious wines, and food from local restaurants. Additionally, the Coomers are making progress on their new Vista Tasting Room set to open this summer.

Temecula was also well represented. There was a whole section at the show with over 10 Temecula wineries. We visited one of my favorites at the show, Falkner Winery. We caught up

with owners, Ray and Loretta Falkner, along with winemaker Duncan Williams. For Viognier lovers, I recommend Falkner's Viognier. Also included in their tasting offering was their 2022 Sauvignon Blanc, 2021 Syrah, and one of my fav Falkner wines, their Amante Super Tuscan Style wine. For Amante, Williams blends Sangiovese with Merlot, Cab Sauv, and Cab Franc. The palate has black cherry with strawberry notes and earthy undertones on the finish. When visiting Temecula, Falkner Winery's

Pinnacle Restaurant should be at the top of your list for lunch or dinner. While in the Temecula section, we also visited the Doffo and Cougar tables. Perhaps one of my best tastings representing Temecula was not the wine, but Gina LaMora's Grazing Theory Lavish Charcuterie. The meats and cheeses served by Gina and co-worker Karyn were heavenly, especially when topped with raw honeycomb and paired with Cougar Wines.

Finally, I must mention a few upper tier wines I tasted at the Stonestreet Estate Vineyards table. Stonestreet from Alexander Valley is part of the Jackson Family Wines portfolio and is one of the most extensive mountain estates in the world. Only 900 acres of the total 5,000 acres are planted. Cory Rowin, Jackson Family Wines, District Manager, and Chris Cooke, Regal Wine Co., District Manager were pouring

2019 Chardonnay grown at 1,800 feet and 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon with fruit grown at 2,400 feet down to 800 feet.

Another honorable mention was Ehret Family Winery from Knights Valley. Jason Robinson, Director of Sales, was pouring three great Cabs that included their 2019 Cab blend, 2019 Bella's Cab Sauv that was 97% Cab with a splash of Merlot (3%), and their 2019 Hillside Reserve Cab that was 100% Cab Sauv. Of the three, the Bella was a great value at \$85. The Cab is \$75 and the Reserve, \$125.

THE JUDY GARLAND HOUSE IS FOR SALE AT \$11.5 MILLION



One of LA's classic celebrity homes has just come on the market. The Bel-Air home that Judy Garland bought in 1938 – the same year she was signed to star in *The Wizard of Oz*– is for sale at \$11.5 million. Built by architect-to-the-stars Wallace Neff, who also designed homes for Mary Pickford and Douglas Fairbanks, Fredric March, and Charlie Chaplin, Judy lived in the home for several years along with her mother and sisters.

Located in one of Bel-Air's most prestigious neighborhoods and near the Bel-Air Country Club and the Getty Art Museum, the traditional-style home is tucked behind tall hedges on over two acres of lush landscaping and manicured topiaries. Clearly a showplace when it was built in the 1930s and featured in several of the most prominent home magazines such as *Architectural Digest*, the two-story white home and grounds are still a showplace with its circular-gated driveway, prestigious location, and timeless design.

The 5,513-square-foot home includes five en-suite bedrooms and six-and-a-half baths. Although the home has been meticulously updated, it still retains many of the 1930's classic Old

Hollywood features such as the curved staircase and iron railing from the entry foyer to the second floor. The home has a generously sized living room, several fireplaces, a sunroom, dark hardwood floors, a large bay window, molded walls, and a touch of Art Deco ambiance. There is an extra-large chef's kitchen with a marble island and top-of-the-line appliances, dining room, office, dressing room, dual walk-in closets, and several conversation areas.

The home's exterior is just as impressive as the interior with its tree-framed entrance, backyard rolling grass hills, large brick-lined patio for entertaining friends or large groups, a unique vine-covered railing and brick steps that transverse the rolling hills, more trees, hedges and topiaries, and an extravagant in-ground pool. The backyard truly creates a space of peace and tranquility, perfect for an afternoon of quiet relaxation or an evening with friends. A backyard writer's cottage is original to the home with built-in cabinets and a fireplace and makes a perfect work-from-home studio or could be converted into a guest home.

Judy was born in 1922 as Frances Ethel Gumm and got her start in show



business as a vaudeville child performer with her sisters in the group *The Gumm Sisters*. She signed with MGM at just age 16 and soon became one of their top stars in *The Wizard of Oz*, *Meet Me In St. Louis* and *Easter Parade*. Later in her career, Judy received Academy Award nominations for her performances in *A Star Is Born* and *Judgement at Nuremberg*. Her famous co-stars included Micky Rooney, Fred Astaire and Gene Kelly. Judy was one of Hollywood's most versatile stars as an actress,

Grammy Award-winning recording artist, and record-setting concert performer in England, Las Vegas and New York. Judy was the youngest recipient of the Cecil B. DeMille Award for lifetime achievement in the film industry but went through years of alcohol, drug and mental issues. She died at age 47 in London from an accidental drug overdose.

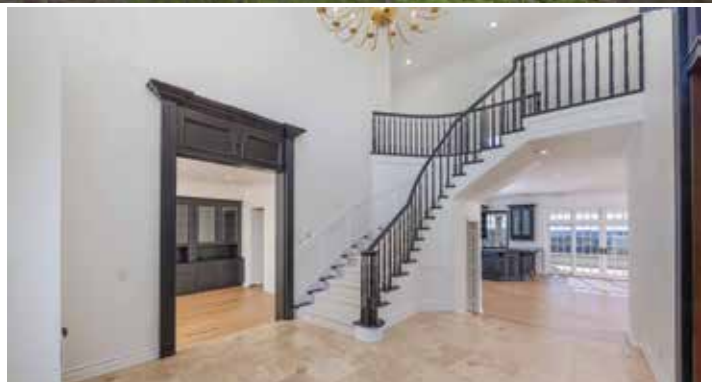
